The Thoracic Society of Australia and New Zealand (TSANZ) is currently accepting submissions for the 2020 Cystic Fibrosis Innovation Grant.

In association with the Australian Cystic Fibrosis Research Trust (ACFRT) and Cystic Fibrosis Australia (CFA), the TSANZ is managing the CF Innovation Grant application and review process.

ACFRT and CFA are fostering CF research with new projects by post-doctoral researchers and in the past three years five Innovation Grants have been funded.

The deadline for 2020 submissions is approaching fast. All applications must be in by the 31st of January so that they can be put up for review. The award will be up to \$80,000 pa.

CFA is looking for new therapies, new drugs and new approaches to cystic fibrosis research. If you are a researcher with a project in the initial feasibility phase, we want to hear from you.

Your project may be new and green, it may lack initial support or pilot data. The Cystic Fibrosis Innovation Grant is looking for projects just like these, we want fresh eyes and new ideas on CF issues.

And it is not just about respiratory research. The gut, reproduction, mental health, comorbidities and the effect of new modulator therapies are all valuable and fascinating areas of research.
