The deadline for our Research Priorities Setting Survey has been extended, but we still need to stay on track for our Research Priorities Summit next year. This program is extremely important to the future of CF in Australia because it will lay down a roadmap for Funding and Advocacy for the next five years.

Priority setting is a crucial practice for research driven organisation, and CFA has always held the philosophy that we work WITH our Community and not separately from them.

We anticipate a lively debate at the Summit because the stakes are extremely high, and the possibilities of CF treatment have never been wide or more optimistic. However, these Priority Surveys are the basis of all further discussions, they are our best indication from the CF Community of how you want our resources to be invested.

We want your focus to be our focus and we are still wide open for suggestions about the comparative importance of transplant research or clinical improvement, or the benefits of improved CF nutrition vs mental health outreach.

Since the Priority Setting Survey is currently in its second generation, we have already had the opportunity to refine our questions and reflect the results of the last survey.

This is a great opportunity to engage with the cause of cystic fibrosis advocacy in Australia and make your own voice heard.
