- 1. Go to https://cfa.padlokt.com
- 2. If this is your first time on Consumer Connect then please click Sign Up. This will consist of establishing your user password and a contact email.
- 3. If you are a returning Consumer Connect user, click on the Log In icon and enter your email and password.
- 4. Once logged in to your Consumer Connect dashboard, scroll down half the page to the Upcoming Connect Sessions section.
- 5. Select the event that you have logged in to participate in.
- 6. Follow the onscreen prompts to check your camera and microphone.
- 7. Click 'Join the Event' at this point, a moderator will be there to greet you and offer any further assistance.
