Bradley was only three weeks old when the doctors performed a 'Guthrie's test' otherwise known as the 'heel prick test' and was diagnosed with cystic fibrosis (CF).

At the time, Bradley's parents had no idea about this disease. One of the first Doctors they spoke with explained CF to them, stating that Bradley would be better with a terminal illness, as that would either kill him, or he would recover, but tragically he explained that CF would ruin Bradley's life!



Bradley's parents knew that living with CF would be tough and that it was going to be a difficult battle but they were committed to do all the right things so that Bradley could have the best life possible.

That was 26 years ago.

Bradley has endured tough times, but his attitude has always remained positive.

He does this so that others can also see his positive and optimistic outlook and feel the same.
